Regular care helps maintain surface texture, color vibrancy, player safety and consistent ball bounce. Routine Court Maintenance

- Remove leaves, dust and debris regularly.
- Rinse the court with clean water weekly.
- Perform monthly deep cleaning using mild detergent.
- Inspect court edges and drainage channels.
- Remove standing water after rainfall.
- Schedule annual professional inspections.

Frequency	Maintenance Task
After Use	Remove debris and dust
Weekly	Wash surface with clean water
Monthly	Deep cleaning and inspection
Quarterly	Drainage and perimeter checks
Annually	Professional surface inspection

Care Guidelines & Best Practices

Maintaining a clean court prevents staining, mold growth and premature wear. Courts should be kept free from organic debris, chemicals and abrasive cleaning tools.

Do's	
Use soft nylon brooms	
Remove standing water	
Inspect drainage systems	
Use mild cleaning solutions	
Schedule inspections	

Common Maintenance Issues

- Dirt accumulation reducing traction.
- Standing water causing surface wear.
- Mold and mildew in shaded areas.
- Cracks requiring prompt repair.
- Drainage blockages affecting court performance.
